SUZY LAMPLUGH TRUST 20th ANNIVERSARY CONCERT

On Saturday 1st July, St Mary's Church, Newport is hosting a concert by Tempus Choir to mark the 20th Anniversary of the Suzy Lamplugh Trust. From small beginnings the Trust - set up by Suzy's parents, Paul and Diana Lamplugh - has become a national charity and is widely recognised as the leading authority on personal safety. It is dedicated to the reduction of aggression and violence in our society and the promotion of safer living for everyone.

Newport has been chosen for this event because Suzy loved the place, the open sea and the coast. Here she spent some of her happiest times in the company of her family and friends - living her life to the full - she was an active windsurfer in the early days of the art. Those who knew her speak of her generous and outgoing personality and her deep attachment to Pembrokeshire.

The concert includes the African Sanctus by David Fanshawe, some spirituals and 'Antiphony of a Grief Rewarded' - a choral work created in memory of Suzy Lamplugh by the composer Seimon Morris - set to the words of the poet Peter George. The work had a well received premiere in St David's Cathedral and a rapturous reception at its first London performance. It has since been recorded and CDs will be available at the concert.
